

The 2nd annual Wright County Law Enforcement Torch Run Half Marathon & 5K for Special Olympics Minnesota will be held Saturday, May 5, 2012 at Sturges Park, Highway 25 & 2nd Avenue S on Buffalo Lake, Buffalo, MN 55313. Registration is from 6:30-7:30 a.m., opening ceremonies start at 7:35 a.m., and the half-marathon run and 5K run/walk begins at 8 a.m.

The half marathon is a challenging course through the beautiful (and hilly!) Wright County countryside. Please note is this an open course with some gravel. The 5K is open to all ages and ability levels - walk or run at your own pace.

All participants will receive a 2012 Law Enforcement Torch Run short sleeved shirt.

Parking is available at Sturges Park and in surrounding neighborhoods.

As a new addition this year, we are adding a 5K! The 5K will not be timed; however, there will be a large clock at the beginning and end of race for those who want to track their own time.

Children 5 and under are FREE to participate in the 5K if pushed in a stroller, buggy or carried by an adult. Child does not receive a shirt and is not eligible to win an award. You will not need to register the child.
